10th Annual Mid-Maryland USBC Women's Championship Rules

1. Entry will be open to female members of the Mid-Maryland USBC. **Bowlers must be an Association member two weeks prior to the tournament start (February 3, 2024).** Failure to meet these criteria shall be cause for disqualification and forfeiture of all entry fees and any prize or awards.
2. Handicap shall be 90% of 220
3. Average Requirement
 - a. Entrant shall use their highest certified Mid-Maryland USBC average established in any USBC certified league from the previous winter season 2022-2023 based on 21 games or more. If no Mid-Maryland USBC average, then highest USBC certified average from the previous winter season 2022-2023 based on 21 games or more
 - b. USBC rule 319a-1 (summer average) will apply only if no certified winter average is available.
 - c. If an entrant has no previous season certified USBC average, they must use their highest current USBC certified average for 21 games or more from any Association per USBC Rule 319a-1. In addition, entrant must furnish a league standing sheet with written verification from their league secretary as of February 3, 2024.
 - d. If none of the above applies, entrant must use an average of 220 with no handicap.
 - e. Average verification request must be submitted with registration form; if not received by then, entrant shall use an average of 220 with no handicap.
 - f. USBC rules 319a- 2 (10 pin up rule) and 319e will not apply.
4. The entry fees will be \$25 per person, per event; broken down: \$10.50 lineage, \$12.50 prize fund and \$2.00 expense fee for There are two optional entry fees for all events – handicapped \$5 and scratch \$10. **All entry forms and full fees must be submitted to the tournament director by February 3, 2024.** If tournament registration has not reached capacity, registration deadline will be extended to permit walk-ins.
5. Each team shall consist of four bowlers. Participation shall be in accordance with the following rules: a) No more than two players can compete on the same team more than once; b) Entrants may bowl multiple times in the Doubles & Singles events and must bowl in both events. You must change doubles partners for each entry; c) Doubles will be bowled first, and then singles; d) a bowler's first team and first doubles/singles event scores will count for All-Events; e) Members of the PBA are limited to two members on a four person team and one member on a doubles team.
6. Team captains may begin to check in their team 30 minutes before scheduled time to bowl and shall present USBC membership cards for each member of their team. Doubles and singles entrants shall check in together and present their USBC membership cards. Lane assignments will be provided at time of check-in.
7. The tournament director must be advised of substitutions at least one hour prior to scheduled time of bowling. Any bowler arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl but her score will count beginning in the frame she enters the game. A score of zero (0) will be given for frames missed. A substitute will not be required to reimburse the original entrant with the entry fee paid, nor shall the substitute be expected to give the original entrant any prize money or trophy she may win. All events entry fee may be transferred to substitutes if a substitute bowls all three events for the same person and the original entrant has paid the all events fee(s).
8. In the case of disability after the game has started, a substitute shall be allowed in the team and doubles events only. The combined scores are to count in either of these events. If no substitute is available, only the actual score of the frames bowled shall count. Scores bowled through the efforts of more than one individual shall not qualify for any USBC or tournament individual award nor shall the score be included in the all events total.
9. Cash prizes in the tournament will be awarded in each of the events for Scratch and Handicap performances. Prize fund will be paid at a ratio of one for each five entries (1:5) with a split of 80% for handicap and 20% for scratch. All events will be paid out at a ratio of 1:5
10. A team or an individual can win both titles and the highest cash prize in each of the events. If a team or an individual should place first in both divisions they will receive the titles and chevron for both divisions and the highest cash award to which they are entitled
11. The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the Mid-Maryland USBC, Inc. its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought on by war, national emergency or causes relating thereto or resulting there from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the Mid-Maryland USBC, Inc.
12. USBC Rules will prevail when not specifically covered in the above. The Tournament director in conjunction with the board of directors of the Mid-Maryland USBC will decide any questions not covered by USBC or these tournament rules. The board shall have power to hear and act on all protests arising from or under construction of the rules of the tournament.
